

Bibliography of Works of Professor Keiichi Takeuchi

This bibliography does not claim to be complete, or exhaustive. Writings appearing in various encyclopedias, weekly magazines and newspapers, and most of the non academic writings have been omitted. In this list, writings which appear, sometimes with some modifications, in the author's later publications are omitted. The writings are divided into books, articles, and book reviews. For each division, writings are arranged chronologically. The original spelling mistakes are corrected, but the mistakes of phonetic representations of persons' names, are not corrected. Russian titles are latinized and for writings in Japanese, the Western language titles are in parentheses. Some Japanese periodical titles have official translations into Western languages as follows:
